This fall, we're launching *Common Thread*—a new conversation series from SkillSource featuring the people shaping workforce in North Central Washington: board members, community partners, frontline leaders, and the occasional program participant.

## **§** Funding Update

SkillSource is expanding our reach! Supporting justice-involved individuals with training, employment, and wraparound services in Chelan County.

### **RESET (Reentry, Skills, Employment & Training)**

SkillSource, in partnership with South Central Workforce, received a \$4M *Pathway Home* grant from the U.S. Department of Labor to launch the RESET Program—Reentry, Skills, Employment & Training. This initiative will support 400 justice-involved individuals in Yakima and Chelan Counties with training, credentials, and wraparound services to reduce recidivism and help people transition into long-term employment.

## WorkSource Central Basin Fall Hiring Event


